Ramsay confirms restaurant opening at One New Change in September

Gordon Ramsay has confirmed that his new restaurant and bar, Bread Street Kitchen, will open next month at Land Securities One New Change development in the City.

Bread Street Kitchen will open on 26 September at One New Change which also houses Jamie Oliver and Adam Perry-Lang's US barbecue-inspired restaurant Barbecoa.

The restaurant will be an all-day casual dining concept open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. It is the first London restaurant opening from Gordon Ramsay Holdings since former chief executive Chris Hutcheson left the company.

It will be set in a large and dramatic warehouse space with reclaimed furniture and vintage armchairs. It will also include a wine balcony stretching along the wall above the kitchen and a wood burning oven.

Restaurant Property director David Rawlinson, who advised Gordon Ramsay, commenting on the opening said: "We acquired three restaurants in this great new scheme which has brought a new dynamism to the City and the two that are open Zizzi and Byron trade very well, so I am sure this will be a great success given that Gordon will be a great added attraction."
